World Telecom Day Celebrations:

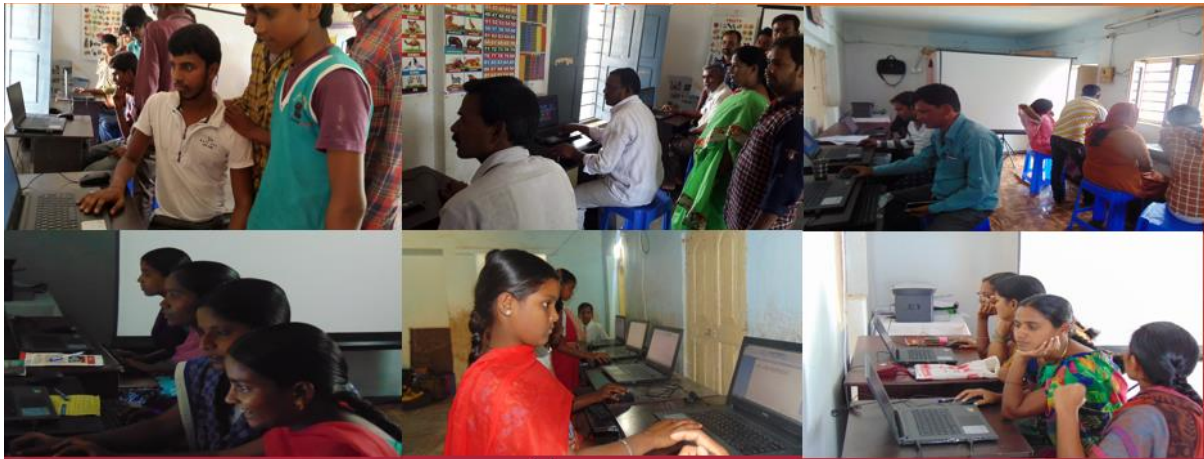
- We celebrated World Telecom Day in Srirangapuram Village at our Computer Training Centre.

- Through these programmes nearly 1000 students and other people are benefitted.

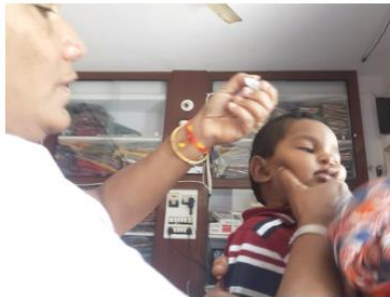




Pulse Polio Programme:

ADD THE INCOME TAX CLAUSE:

Proviso to that effect that no addition alternation amendment in the objects shall be made without the prior approval of the Director of Income Tax(Exemptions) Hyd.
